



INSTRUCTIONS FOR CERTIFICATION OF POWER OF ATTORNEY DOCUMENTS

**THE FOLLOWING PERSONS MAY WITNESS
THE DOCUMENT AS FOLLOWS:**

A. Within the Island of Jamaica

1. A Justice of the Peace. The JP must attach his/her Seal to the document and state the parish he is appointed for; **or**
2. The Governor General; **or**
3. Any of the Judges of the Supreme Court

B. In Great Britain, or Northern Ireland

1. A Notary Public (this also applies to any Commonwealth Country); **or**
2. The Mayor or Deputy Mayor of City, Town or Borough; **or**
3. The Chief Magistrate or Deputy Chief Magistrate of any City, Town or Borough

In any other Foreign State

1. A Notary Public: The Notary Public must attach his/her seal to the document and state when his commission expires. *After the Notary Public has signed, the member must take the document, to the County Clerk's Office for the Country Clerk to attached his/her certificate to the document; **OR***
2. The Jamaican or the British Consular which includes the Consul-General, Consul and Vice-Consul, any other person for the time being, discharging the duties of Consul General or Vice Consul;
