## **COK Sodality Credit Union Awards Over Half Million Dollars in Academic Scholarships and Grants**

COK Sodality Co-operative Credit Union has awarded over half a million dollars in academic bursaries, grants, and scholarships to primary, secondary and tertiary students who have performed exceptionally at their respective levels.

At its' recently concluded awards ceremony for its annual scholarship programme held at its headquarters on Slipe Road, over 20 recipients were awarded cash incentives through the Paul Chevannes Scholarship, the Carter-Carter Scholarships, the Bertie Morris Scholarships and the Margaret Rodgers Foundation Grant programme.

The Paul Chevannes Scholarship which is valued at \$75,000, is issued every two years to a student who is pursuing tertiary studies.

The Carter –Carter scholarship was awarded to students who will be returning to high schools. These recipients have excelled at both academics and extra-curricular activities. Each scholarship is valued at \$20,000 per annum for a period of 5 years.

The Bertie Morris Scholarship covers primary through to secondary level studies, is awarded to employees' children, 12 years and younger, who have attained at least a B+ average.

The Margaret Rodgers Foundation Grant for secondary-level studies, is valued at an annual sum of \$25,000 for a duration of 5 years. This is the only COK Sodality scholarship support that requires the recipient to be a resident of Kingston & St. Andrew, have grave financial need, and attain high academic standard.
